BACKGROUND

Within Pillar IV of the Project; "Water Governance" SWIM-SM is performing several tasks with the aim to enhance knowledge on water governance at the local level and identify concrete actions for improving local water management and reinforcing users' participation.

- Two activities were foreseen during Year 1 Workplan:
- **1.Identify status of WUAs in the PCs;**
- 2.Share experiences through organization of a regional experts group workshop;

1. Identify status of WUAs in the PCs

A regional assessment on the status of water users' participation in the PCs was carried out for SWIM-SM by CIHEAM/IAMB with case studies (Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon & Tunisia);

OBJECTIVE:

•Illustrate the range of experiences in irrigation water users' participation

- Compile information on the status of WUAs
- Take stock of achieved progress & lessons learnt

•Identify measures and policy options to improve the efficiency of WUAs, including targeted activities to be implemented under the SWIM-SM project.

2. Organization of a Regional Experts Group Workshop

OBJECTIVE:

•Review, discuss & validate with the national partners the findings of the regional assessment:

•Promote sharing of experiences & BPs between PCs in the establishment & operationalisation of WUAs involving both successful & less successful interventions

•Identify the gaps & main priority actions including capacity building & training that can be taken up by SWIM-SM during its life time with the aim to improve local water management and enhance users participation

 - Brief country presentations exchange of experience
 - >Workgroups sessions
- The workshop will be moderated by a professional facilitator with international experience

Expected Outcome

The regional assessment report is validated, complimented and amended based on participants' deliberations and recommendations;

- □ Gaps to be bridged and priority actions to be undertaken by SWIM-SM are identified;
- □ Training & Capacity buildings needs specified.
- Best practices with regard to the operation of water users' associations are identified and documented.
