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
#### Water - an issue in Provence Alpes Côte d'Azur (PACA)

• Mediterranean climate progressing to mountain climate from 800m altitude


•Average annual rainfall of approx. 600 mm (= Paris) but **unevenly distributed** with summer drought, three times fewer rainy days

• Hydrology contrast between the coastline, the plains, the mountains, but also according to seasons and years.

•Summer drought and severe floods (June 2010 and November 2011 in Var) are the characteristic signs of hydrology in PACA





**DREAL**: Regional Directorate for the Environment, Planning and Housing: •Operational missions: hydrometry, hydrobiology

In the 6 departments and at national level:

.Mobilization and steering to implement national policy

.Participates in planning (SDAGE)

Expert missions

DDT (M): Departmental Directorate of Territories (and the Sea), head of MISE (Inter-S

.Processing "water police" files

•Operational implementation of water policy guidelines

Inspections and their administrative and criminal follow-up

# From water police to environmental police

Methods of organization and operation established since late 1990s: MISE (Inter-Service

Better action coordination and exchanges facilitated on files in issue = successful.

Since 2009, seeking to expand this organization to the topic of Nature: MISEN (inter-service water and nature mission): chaired by the prefect, validation of iss MIPE (inter-service mission of environmental **police units**): prefect + public prosecutors

Originality in PACA: Environmental Policy Committees (COPOLLEN) since 2009 in some

#### DREAL:

Regional Directorate for the Environment, Planning and Housing: coordination of water policing but involved in other environmental policing

- 560 agents approximately
  - •6 services
    - General Secretariat
    - Transport and infrastructures
    - Water, biodiversity, landscape: policing of water, nature, sites, publicity
    - Energy, construction, air, dam: hydroelectricity, dams
    - Prevention of natural and technlogical risks: ICPE
    - Territories, evaluation, knowledge, development, housing
  - 6 territorial units (one per department)
  - The Director is territorial delegate for the Nuclear Security Authority (ASN)

### **Environmental police units**

Numerous stakeholders:

- State services:DREAL, DDT(M), DDPP, ARS, Customs, DIRM.
- Public institutions: ONEMA, ONCFS, ONF, National Parks, Agency of marine protected areas, for conservation of the coastline.
- Investigation services: police and gendarmerie

Under multiple authorities:

• prefect of region, maritime prefect, prefects of departments, public prosecutors

Under several administrations:

Ministries of the environment and agriculture

In implementation of numerous laws:

• Codes of environment, forestry, rural, public health

# Improve the effectiveness of environmental policing

DREAL has implemented **regional coordination of environmental policing** in collaboration with State departmental services and public institutions in order to:

- Increase synergies between actors
- .Foster operational coordination
- .Improve links with public prosecutors
- .Share experience
- Professionalize agents
- Provide judicial experience
- .Communicate, exchange

### **Coordination in PACA**

.Since 2009:

•Creation of a committee (or commission) for environmental police (COPOLEN)

•Operation of State / public prosecutor:

 Annual strategic meeting chaired by the prefects and cochaired by public prosecutors: issues, objectives, strategic priorities

•Biannual operational meetings chaired by public prosecutors: current issues, organizational arrangements.

•Progress:

COPOLLEN in Var

COPOLEN integrated in MISEN in Vaucluse

- •MISEN and COLAEN in Bouches-du-Rhône
- •COPOLEN in Alpes-Maritimes, MISEN

•MISEN and MIPE underway in Hautes Alpes and Alpes de Haute Provence

### **Coordination in PACA**

.Benefit:

- Sharing control strategy with public prosecutors
- •Inter-service exchanges, with public prosecutors, on files with multiple challenges
- •Developing strategies to complete significant cases and/or significant environmental impacts
- Identification of key contacts
- Sharing good practices

•Led by the Public Prosecutor of Draguignan

•at the request of the custodian

•the operation assembled the services of the Gendarmerie, ONF, ONCFS, Coastline Conservation, General Council of Var, manager of RNN

# The link with town planning

The powers of pure town planning:

- •Departmental Directorates of Territories (and the Sea) DDT (M)
- •Bodies, links between local authorities, villages

.Town planning and environmental issues may be linked:

- Construction in a classified site without authorization
- Clearing, deforestation, unauthorized
- Storage of materials
- •Urban development/ wastewater treatment plant, drinking water catchment.

**.**COPOLLEN type structures are a way to connect "environmental" and "town planning" issues.
