OBJECTIVES OF PROPOSED 2015 ACTIVITIES

- ❖ Refine MONEVAS to incorporate partners' recommendations from the 2 pilot countries
- ❖ Assist in anchoring the utilisation of MONEVAS in the 2 countries
- ❖ Expand the application of MONEVAS to all WUAs in a selected regions
- ❖ Document the approach and the lessons learnt during implementation
- ❖ Disseminate the system and promote its use among the PCs, relevant donors and Regional Organisations

EXPECTED OUTPUTS

- ❖ MONEVAS is refined.
- ❖ Its application is expanded to all WUAs within selected regions & tested at an aggregated level.
- ❖ Its utilisation is anchored in the 2 pilot countries & integrated into the business functions.
- ❖ Capacity in the application of the MONEVAS is extended to trainers
- ❖ > 50 users with improved capacity in M&E of PIM/IMT & WUAs.
- ❖ BPs in the implementation of PIM/IMT are promoted in designated regions.
- ❖ Lessons learnt are documented and report disseminated to the PCs
- ❖ MONEVAS is promoted among PCs, donors & regional organisations for follow up and replication

SOW - 3. Train partners & trainers

❖ Training will target:

- WUA support unit
- One regional office
- All the WUAs within a region
- Midlevel experts to be hired either individually, or as part of a service subcontract with an adequately skilled NGO in related matters.
- Cellules de promotion” (CP) des GDAs

❖ The training methodology will vary between Jordan and Tunisia.

❖ To ensure transfer of know-how

Midlevel experts will also be assisting in the application of the MONEVAS

Envisaged no. of trainees = 50

SCOPE OF WORK

4. Assist partners in application of the MONEVAS and the implementation of the new/revised procedures

to be applied on data for one quarter

5. Conduct a self-evaluation workshops

2 days in Jordan

3-days workshop in Tunisia

6. Prepare implementation report with lessons learnt

7. Optional: Organise Regional Workshop

8. Dissemination Activities

OPTIONS FOR DISSEMINATION

1.	Prepare short handbook about the system including its benefits
2.	Organise visits to IFAD and FAO in Rome and present the system
3. Scen. 1	Organise and conduct meetings with donors to promote replication (4 countries)
3. Scen. 2	Organise exchange visits to present the system for the Mashreq and Maghreb countries
4.	<i>Promote System in regional meetings (AWC)</i>
