- KE and NKEs provided support to countries in identifying and drafting solutions

Valid solutions collected so far

- + Environment police
- + Wastewater treatment
- + Treated wastewater reuse
- + Water Users Associations
- + Participatory management of water resources
- + PPPs for funding water infrastructure
- + Grey water reuse
- + Improved yields for drought resistant wheat
- + Solar desalination

Solutions

Rejected solutions

- ideas without tangible results
- proposals requesting funding for activities
- lacked data preventing assessment and possible replicability

The remaining solutions fit the required criteria and are valid for screening by a selection committee in an event
